## Lake-Sumter Community College Offering Two New Non-Credit Courses

LEESBURG (September 1, 2009) - Lake-Sumter Community College's Continuing Education office strives to offer classes that are practical, educational, fun...and unique. This month they are introducing two classes to bring out everyone's creative talents.

Students of all ages will enjoy the Colored Pencil art class taught by well-know local artist Lew Clayton. An illustrator of three books, Clayton was the designer of this year's colorful wildlife logo for LSCC's Kids' College. He will teach his class how to create colorful pencil drawings using Prismacolor colored pencils. With over a hundred colors, they are easy to use and a very mobile art tool. Different methods of layering such as cross-hatching and burnishing will be practiced, as well as working on different types of papers. Colored Pencil classes start September 17 and run on consecutive Thursdays through October 22. Offered on the Leesburg Campus from 6:30 until 8:30 p.m., the cost of the course is \$69.

For those students wanting to use their home or office as their canvas, the South Lake Campus' new Introduction to Interior Decorating class will provide both the artistic and practical inspiration needed. The class will learn the necessary skills and the important fundamentals of some of the best decorating techniques, including the different elements of design, principles of color, fabrics and window treatments, flooring, and the tricks-of-the-trade room accessorizing. The class meets on Thursdays, beginning September 24 and continuing through October 29, from 6 until 8 p.m. Cost is only \$69.
