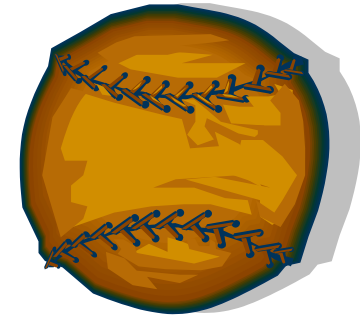

Softball Camp Information

Camp Breakdown

Session #1

The LSCC Softball Camp is devoted entirely to teaching softball skills. Players spend the entire week learning and practicing softball fundamentals with emphasis on individual development, improvement, and fun. The camp will help each participant develop self-confidence, sportsmanship, and teamwork.

Session #2

This camp is designed for girls ages 15 -18. Participants will receive individual instruction to fine tune their skill and ability in their specialized position. The focus will be on specific fundamentals the player needs, along with an emphasis on the roles the individual would have to play on their team. This camp is great for a player who is seeking to tryout or play on their high school team.

Individual campers will be placed into groups of similar skills and ability.
