

## **Criminal Justice Articulation**

### **Lake Technical Center, Inc. and Lake-Sumter Community College**

Lake Technical Center, Inc. and Lake-Sumter Community College agree to cooperate in the establishment, maintenance, and implementation of a discipline specific agreement for Law Enforcement, Correctional Officer, and Criminal Justice Technology.

#### **Articulated Components of this Agreement**

##### Law Enforcement

Lake-Sumter Community College will award up to twenty-one (21) college credit hours in the Associate in Science or Associate in Applied Science degree program in Criminal Justice for those individuals who have satisfactorily completed the 760-hour Law Enforcement Program at Lake Technical Center, Inc.

College credit will be awarded for the following:

CJE 1002 Introduction to Law Enforcement	3 credits
CJL 2102 Criminal Procedure and Evidence	3 credits
CJE 2115 Police and Society	3 credits
CJE 2500 Police Operations	3 credits
CJE 2946 Criminal Justice Practicum	3 credits
Criminal Justice Electives (Law Enforcement)	6 credits*
Total	21 credits

##### Correctional Officer

Lake-Sumter Community College will award up to fifteen (15) college credit hours in the Associate in Science or Associate in Applied Science degree program in Criminal Justice for those individuals who have satisfactorily completed the 530-hour Correctional Officer Program at Lake Technical Center, Inc.

College credit will be awarded for the following:

CCJ 1000 Introduction to Corrections	3 credits
CJC 2160 Community Based Corrections	3 credits
CJE 2946 Criminal Justice Practicum	3 credits
Criminal Justice Electives (Corrections)	6 credits*
Total	15 credits

**\*NOTE: A maximum of nine (9) Criminal Justice elective credits may be awarded to students who hold both Law Enforcement and Correctional Officer**

**Certifications. (Only three credits of the Criminal Justice Practicum can be applied towards dual certification articulation.)**

**Provisions of this Agreement**

To receive college credit in the AS or AAS degree program in Criminal Justice, students must successfully complete 6 credit hours at LSCC and submit to the LSCC Admissions Office for approval a completed Articulated Credit Transfer form accompanied by certified copies of the Lake Technical Center Certificate of Completion for Law Enforcement or Correctional Officer and the State of Florida Criminal Justice Standards and Training (CJST) Certificate of Compliance.

This agreement is effective for the 2006-2007 academic year as defined by Lake-Sumter Community College and Lake Technical Center, Inc. and shall be subject to annual review and renewal by Lake-Sumter Community College and Lake Technical Center, Inc. at the end of aforementioned academic year. Any modifications, additions, or deletions to this agreement must be in writing and signed by the signatories of this document or their successors.
